There are five categories of membership:

- Personal: Any individual engaged in some form of Law Librarianship. Fee - US \$20.00.
- 2. **Institutional**: Any organization that has a legal collection or a collection of government documents. *Fee US \$100.00*
- **3. Associate**: Any individual or organization not eligible for personal or institutional membership. *Fee US \$15.00*
- **4. Student**: Any student registered as a student in librarianship or law. *Fee US* \$5.00
- 5. **Honorary**: Conferred by the CARALL Executive Committee to an individual who has made substantial contribution to Law Librarianship, the legal profession or to CARALL. *Free*
